### **Part-Time Doping Control Officer of the Hong Kong Anti-Doping Committee**

Under the auspices of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Anti-Doping Committee (HKADC) is an organization responsible for planning and implementing the anti-doping programme in Hong Kong. We are now looking for right candidates for the captioned position.

#### **Duties:**

The successful candidates will mainly be responsible for carrying out sample collection procedures in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Agency standards and other related duties.

#### **Requirements:**

The applicant should have: (a) a recognized university degree or equivalent; (b) good command of written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese essential and Putonghua preferred); (c) ability to follow procedures and protocols; (d) proven ability to work with confidential information; (e) conflict management skills in a stressful situation; (f) availability to work at both office and non-office hours within short notice; and (g) first-aid, phlebotomy, and/or other medical-related qualifications will be an advantage.

#### **Training & Examination:**

Short-listed candidates will have to attend a one-day mandatory training (tentatively scheduled in July 2019), complete a self-study programme, and pass a proficiency examination (date to be confirmed) to be certified.

#### **Remuneration:**

Upon certification, Doping Control Officer will be remunerated on mission basis or on hourly basis.

#### **Application:**

All applications will be treated in the strictest confidence. Personal data provided will be used strictly in accordance with the Personal Data Policies. Applicants who do not hear from us within 8 weeks after the closing date may assume their applications unsuccessful. All information on unsuccessful candidates will be destroyed within 6 months. Shortlisted candidates may be required to provide reference before or shortly after interview.
