本會作為地區奧委會，任何時候均需根據國際奧委會《奧林匹克憲章》的規定，秉持奧林匹克精神，透過運動以促進友誼、團結及公平競爭。

故此，本會在尊重運動員及體育工作者表達意見的同時，亦希望藉此機會提醒有關人士，在公開表達意見時，緊記謹言慎行，切實遵守《奧林匹克憲章》及本會《章程細則》內的相關守則。

所有屬下體育總會需將此訊息發放予有關持份者，包括運動員、教練、委員及職員等，使訊息得以更廣泛流傳。

### **SF&OC's Statement in Response to Public Expression of Opinion by Athletes on Social Media**

In response to the recent enquiries received by the Federation concerning the public expression of opinion by athletes on social media regarding the recent events in Hong Kong, the Federation would like to make the following statement:

As a National Olympic Committee and to uphold the "Olympic Charter" of the International Olympic Committee, the Federation is obliged to advocate the principles of Olympism at all times and to promote friendship, solidarity and fair play through sports.

Therefore, while respecting the right to freedom of expression of athletes and sports-related personnel, the Federation would like to take this opportunity to remind all members of the sports community to exercise prudence when expressing opinions in public to ensure compliance with the relevant rules of the "[Olympic Charter](#)" and the Federation's "[Articles of Association](#)".

All National Sports Associations under the Federation are required to promulgate this message to relevant stakeholders, including athletes, coaches, officials, staff members, etc. to ensure widest circulation.
