Report to the Council Meeting of The Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong 12 December 2016

1 International Event held in Hong Kong

YONEX-SUNRISE Hong Kong Open Badminton Championships 2016 part of the MetLife BWF World Superseries

The 6-day “Yonex-Sunrise Hong Kong Open Badminton Championships 2016 – Part of the MetLife BWF World Superseries”, sanctioned by Badminton World Federation, was held between 22 and 27 November at Hong Kong Coliseum. It is one of the BWF’s Superseries events and is a “M” Mark tournament recognized by the Major Sports Events Committee.

Grand prize money is over HK\$3,100,000. 263 world-class players from 22 countries and regions to compete for the crown, including Rio Olympic Champions and most of world ranking top 10 players. Hong Kong Team historically awarded 1 Gold 3 Bronze in the event.

It was full house with over 5,000 spectators on Finals and the total number of audience for the event is over 23,000.

2 Local Event

2.1 International Badminton Star Demonstration cum Funday

Organized by the Association and sponsored by Bank of China (Hong Kong). The event was held on 26 November 2016 at Hong Kong Coliseum. Members of China and Malaysian Badminton Team were invited, together with Hong Kong team players, to provide skill demonstration and have fun-play with over 400 members of public from local community.

2.2 2017 Hong Kong Badminton Doubles League

Organized by the Association and subvented by LCSD. The event attracted over 520 teams to participate and will be held from January to May 2017 in various LCSD sports centres.

2.3 The Demonstration and Promotion Day for Central and Western District

Organized by LCSD and supported by HKBA. The event was held on 24 September at Hong Kong Park Sports Centre.

2.4 School Sports Programme

School Sports Programme is organized by National Sports Association and subvented by the LCSD. It is co-ordinated and implemented by the LCSD and co-organized by the Education Bureau, the Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Hong Kong Baptist University. Coaches are arranged to schools for Easy Sport Programme and Outreach Coaching Programme for 38 courses in October, 44 courses in November, 48 courses in December respectively.

2.5 Umpire Continuing Education Programme (Umpires Workshops 2016)

Umpires Workshops were held from 11 to 12 November 2016 at Olympic House. The workshops included Elementary Umpires Workshop and Advanced Umpires Workshop. 48 elementary umpires and 15 advanced umpires were accepted to the course. HKBA planned to hold an Umpires Workshops before the Hong Kong Open 2016 (International Badminton Competitions) to enable the local umpires have a revision in Laws of Badminton, Recommendations to technical officials, etc.

1. International Events:

1.1 China National Acrobatic Gymnastics Judges & Coaches Training Course

The course was held in Chengdu, China from 15th to 19th September 2016. Mr. LI Chun Keung, our Vice Convener of Acrobatic Gymnastics Technical Committee, was selected to attend the course. This was a great opportunity to get updated information about judging rules of the new cycle and exchange experiences in coaching and learning new elements.

1.2 5th Asian Gymnaestrada

Our Federation has been invited by the China Gymnastics Association to participate in the 5th Asian Gymnaestrada, which was held from 20th to 24th September 2016 in Qingdao, China. More than 10,000 gymnasts from seven federations – Australia, China, Finland, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea and Malaysia – came together for this 5-day Gymnastics for All Festival. Our team consisted of 1 official and 32 performers and they enjoyed the trip so much.

1.3 Asian Gymnastics Union Congress 2016

The Asian Gymnastics Union (AGU) organized the AGU Congress in Incheon, Korea during the period 26th to 29th September 2016. Dr. CHAN Kam Hung, our Vice Chairperson, and Mr. Albert NG, our Senior Sports Executive attended the meeting. This was a great chance to communicate with other Asian Gymnastics Federations. During the meeting, it was approved that one training course for Men's Artistic Gymnastics will be held in Hong Kong in late November this year.

1.4 FIG Artistic Gymnastics World Challenge Cup (Hungary)

The Championships was held from 5th to 10th October 2016 in Szombathely, Hungary. Mr. JIM Man Hin competed with a group of elite gymnasts from other countries. He was successfully got into the Men's Vault Final and achieved the 4th Runner-up.

1.5 81st FIG Congress

The 81st Congress organized by the Fédération Internationale de Gymnastique (FIG) was held from 18th to 21st October 2016 in Tokyo, Japan. Prof. CHEUNG Siu Yin, MH, our Chairperson, and Mr. Albert NG, our Senior Sports Executive attended the meeting. It marked a turning point in the history of the Federation as Mr. Morinari Watanabe (JPN) had been elected to be the new President after the stepping down of Mr. Bruno Grandi (ITA), who has run the FIG for 20 years. We would also like to express our heartfelt thanks to the Japanese Gymnastics Association for the wonderful welcome and for their excellent hospitality.

1.6 FIG Level I Academy for Trampoline Gymnastics

Two of our Trampoline coaches: Mr. Simon FUNG and Mr. IP Ho Yin, were nominated to attend the Academy, which was held in Manila, Philippines from 8th to 16th November 2016. Fifteen coaches participated from six FIG member federations of the Asian Gymnastics Union – Hong Kong, Indonesia, India, Iran, Pakistan and Philippines. The majority of participants had very good examination results on the two-part theory and practical examination. Congratulations to Simon who hit the third highest marks among all participants.

1.7 China National Acrobatic Gymnastics Championships 2016

The competition was held in Yangzhou, China from 10th to 17th November 2016. Three men and eight women gymnasts competed in the event. Our team achieved great results during the competition, including four gold medals in Women's Pair, Men's Pair and Mixed Pair, 3 silver medals in Women's Pair and Mixed Pair, and a bronze medal in Women's Pair.

1.8 AGU Men's Artistic Gymnastics Common Training Camp

The training camp was hosted by our Association from 24th to 30th November 2016. Fourteen coaches and five gymnasts attended the training camp from six federations – Iran, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Vietnam, India and Hong Kong, China. The course expert was Dr. WEI Xubo from China. Report to SF & OC 372nd Council Meeting

Hong Kong Rugby has achieved considerable success in the past month on the international rugby stage.

Firstly, our Women's Fifteen's team has qualified for the 2017 Women's Rugby World Cup to be played in Dublin next August.

This remarkable milestone was achieved when the team played Fiji in the first round of the 3 country competition and won 45 -7. The unexpected result was achieved by superior teamwork and skill where the Hong Kong girls brought to the match their best ever performance.

This is the first time a Hong Kong team in any sport has qualified to play in a World Cup competition.

The three corned Qualifying Tournament included Japan, where the Hong Kong women performed at a high level only to go down 8 – 28 to tournament winners, Japan, but both teams advance to the World Cup.

Team coach Jo Hull was very pleased with the effort that the girls showed but warned that a great deal of work will need to be done if Hong Kong is to do well in the 12-team Women's Rugby World Cup next year.

Meanwhile in Malaysia, The Hong Kong U19s men's national team won their fourth successive Asia Rugby U19s championship today, beating Malaysia 67-10 at the UPM Sports Centre in Kuala Lumpur.

The win sends Hong Kong to the 2017 World Rugby Junior Trophy in Uruguay. The eight-team competition will include two Asian entrants for the first time since 2014 when Japan won the tournament, which was hosted in Hong Kong.

The success continued with Hong Kong winning the inaugural Asia Rugby U18 Girls Sevens Championship in Dubai, beating Kazakhstan 12-5 in a tense final played before large crowds at the HSBC World Rugby Sevens Series Dubai tournament.

"This result is really important for women's rugby in Hong Kong. To win on our first outing in this competition is a huge accomplishment. It is a great idea by Asia Rugby to have a tournament at this level, as only Europe is doing it at the moment. We hope it will become an annual competition as we need more opportunities to test ourselves at this level," said coach Sam Feausi.

These victories point to the success of our development programs and the establishment of pathways for young players to be able to move through club and school competitions into Hong Kong national teams.
