**1. Local Event**

(i) Mizuno HK Half Marathon Championships 2016

The Mizuno HK Half Marathon Championships 2016 was organized by the Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, and title sponsored by Ichikawa Sangyo Company Limited, it was held at Tai Mei Tuk on 18 December 2016. 3,080 athletes participated in this event.

(ii) Pre-season Trial cum Relay Carnival 2017

The Pre-season Trial cum Relay Carnival was organized by the Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, it was held at Wan Chai Sports Ground on 15 January 2017. There were 463 athletes and 49 relay teams participated in the event.

(iii) Hong Kong Race Walking Championships 2017

The Hong Kong Race Walking Championships was organized by the Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, it was held at Wan Chai Sports Ground on 15 January 2017. There were 47 athletes participated in this event, this event consisted of 3 Men & 3 Women Categories. Mr. TSE Chun Hung & Ms. NG Sau Man have broken the Hong Kong Men's & Women's Records of 10,000m walk respectively.

(iv) Hong Kong Athletics Series – Series 1

The Hong Kong Athletics Series – Series 1 was organized by Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, subvented by Leisure & Cultural Services Department, it was held at Tseung Kwan O Sports Ground on 25 & 26 February 2017. There were 653 athletes participated in this event, this event composed of Men & Women categories.

**2. Local International Event**

(v) Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2017

Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2017 was organized by Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, title sponsored by Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited, it was held on 12 February 2017. The race is being recognized as IAAF Gold Label Road Race by the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) and M-Mark Event by Major Sports Events Committee. The race consisted of various distances, including 10km, Half Marathon, Marathon, Family Run, and 2 distances for wheelchair athletes (3km & 10km). About 74,000 athletes from more than 50 countries have participated in this event.

**1. International Events:**

**1.1 2<sup>nd</sup> Trampoline Singapore Invitational Championships**

The competition was held in Singapore from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> December 2016. Seven gymnasts were selected to participate in the competition and they achieved excellent results, especially Ms. TEE Yu Fang, who awarded the Champion in Women's Individual (Cat. A); Ms. NG Ka Hei, who awarded the 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up in Women's Individual (Cat. C); and Mr. LAI Shun Hei Marcus, who awarded the 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up in Men's Individual (Cat. C).

**1.2 FIG Men's Artistic Gymnastics International Judges' Course (2017-2020 Cycle) (CHN)**

The course was held in Foshan, China 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> December 2016. There were a total of 130 participants from different provinces of China. Mr. NG Wan Lo, our MAG judge, was nominated to participate in this course and he has received updated rules and regulations of the new 2017-2020 cycle.

**1.3 Pilot Funding Scheme for Youth Sports Exchange – Aerobic Gymnastics Exchange Program**

Subvented by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, the Aerobic Gymnastics Exchange Program was organized in Jiangxi Normal University, China from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> December 2016. The seven-day training camp aimed to establish the network between our Association and Mainland China, increase our gymnasts' skill level, and broaden their horizons and interests in Aerobic Gymnastics

**1.4 Hong Kong Artistic Gymnastics Open & Novice Championships cum International Invitation Championships 2017 (Chiu Wai Chung Cup)**

The competition was held in Hong Kong from 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> January 2017. The seven participating teams included Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, India, Guangdong, China, and Hong Kong, China. Our gymnasts achieved excellent results as listed below:

**1.7 FIG Artistic Gymnastics World Cup 2017 (Melbourne)**
