



The MANAGEMENT COMPANY OF OLYMPIC HOUSE LIMITED (MCOHL), the affiliated company controlled by the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, aim to manage the office space of the local National Sports Associations and provide the assembly facility and I.T. service support at the Olympic House (OH). We are now looking for the right candidate to fill up the post of **Operation Officer (OO)** on contract basis, which is renewable subject to the prevailing condition.

Duties

- (i) To be responsible for all aspects relating to audio-visual equipment and operational duties for events held in OH;
- (ii) To monitor the behaviour of the hirer throughout the event to make sure the compliance of OH's house rules by hires;
- (iii) To coordinate with the appointed contractor on the maintenance works of OH's audio visual & simultaneous interpretation systems;
- (iv) To plan, coordinate and provide audio-visual technical support services for hirers;
- (v) To handle booking matters for hirers;
- (vi) To assist in coordinating and supervising the appointed contractors on building services, repairing, renovation and maintenance at OH;
- (vii) To deal with projects as required under emergency; and
- (viii) To assist Assistant Manager for any construction, maintenance, repairing and renovation works at OH.

Requirement

Applicants should have:

- (i) a post-secondary qualification with Electrical / Mechanical / Building Services Engineering;
- (ii) Three-year working experience or above in property / facilities management, especially in audio-visual system;
- (iii) Registered Electrical Worker with Grade A;
- (iv) Able to communicate in both Cantonese and English; and
- (v) Shift duty is required.

Remuneration

Successful candidate will be appointed on contract basis with monthly basic salary plus gratuity equals to 5% of the total basic salary drawn during the period of contract upon satisfactory completion of the contract. Fringe benefits include MPF, medical, paid leave and employee's insurance.
