Latest Update on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games

(Hong Kong, 30 March 2020) President Timothy FOK of the Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (SF&OC) joined a video conference on 27 March 2020 with the President of International Olympic Committee (IOC), other participants including the representatives of Tokyo 2020 Organizing Committee, Olympic Council of Asia and some other National Olympic Committees.

The IOC President gave an update of the latest progress of the postponement of the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. IOC representative also gave updates on the followings: First, those athletes who have already qualified for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games shall remain qualified. Also, IOC has formed a Task Force to follow up various matters related to the postponement of the Games. IOC hopes to confirm the Games period in 2021 and the qualification procedure for the remaining around 43% quota within coming three weeks.

In the meantime, SF&OC will continue to communicate closely with the IOC and will update NSAs and athletes for their smooth participation to the Games.
