#### **SF&OC Participated in the 39<sup>th</sup> OCA General Assembly and Witnessed the Announcement of Host Cities of 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> Asian Games**

(Hong Kong, 16 December 2020) Mr. Timothy T.T. FOK, GBS, JP, President, Mr. Ronnie M.C. WONG, BBS, JP, Hon. Secretary General and Mr. WONG Po Kee, MH, Hon. Deputy Secretary General, represented the Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (“SF&OC”) participated the 39<sup>th</sup> Council of Asia’s General Assembly held in Muscat, Oman via zoom today (16 December 2020).

During the Assembly, Mr. Timothy FOK, GBS, JP, President of SF&OC and Vice President of OCA, submitted a report on the sports development and promotion in East Asia region. He also participated in the voting of Election of Host City for 2030 Asian Games. After counting the votes, OCA President Sheikh Ahmad Al-Fahad Al-Sabah announced that Doha, Qatar, would host the 21<sup>st</sup> Asian Games in 2030 while Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, would be the host city for the 22<sup>nd</sup> Asian Games in 2034.

In addition, the Assembly also listened the progress of various upcoming Games, including Sanya 6<sup>th</sup> Asian Beach Games, Shantou 3<sup>rd</sup> Asian Youth Games, Hangzhou 19<sup>th</sup> Asian Games and Thailand 6<sup>th</sup> Asian Indoor & Martial Arts Games presented by respective Organization Committees.

SF&OC is pleased to participate in the Assembly to receive updates of the various Games to be held in 2021 and share the joy of awarded host cities. We would continue to work with various Organizing Committees to ensure Hong Kong athletes have a smooth participation in these Games.
