2021 Olympic Day Colouring and Drawing Competition Awards Presentation Ceremony Concluded Today!

"2021 Olympic Day - Colouring and Drawing Competition" (the Competition), organized by the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (SF&OC), concluded on 23 June 2021. The Awards Presentation Ceremony was successfully held today (24 July 2021) at the Sha Tin New Town Plaza (STNTP). The winners are listed in the attachment.

Olympic Day is an annual event to celebrate the establishment of the International Olympic Committee on 23 June 1894 at Paris. In previous years, the SF&OC organized fun runs and sports activities to celebrate this event. In view of the pandemic situation, the SF&OC initiated the organization of the Competition for promoting the Olympism via different platforms. There are altogether four categories in the Competition and the SF&OC is very delighted to receive an overwhelming response for receiving nearly 14,000 entries, which has proven the popularity of the event and the enthusiasm of members of the public to support the Olympic Day.

Mr. TONG Wai Lun, BBS, JP, Chairperson of Olympic Day Organizing Committee of the SF&OC, Mr. CHAN Jick Chi, Jack, JP, Under Secretary for Home Affairs, Home Affairs Bureau, and Ambassador Wada, Consulate-General of Japan in Hong Kong were presenters of the Awards. Mr. TONG expressed his congratulations to all winners, and said: "The Competition aims to provide an opportunity for members of the public to demonstrate their creativity and imagination on Olympic Values through their colouring and drawing, as well as to learn the three pillars of Olympic Day, which is Move, Learn and Discover. "

During the Ceremony, six Olympians including Nicholas Edward CHOI (Fencing), Robyn LAMSAM (Swimming), Arthur LI (Swimming), YIP Pui Yin (Badminton), YIU Kit Ching (Athletics) and WONG Kam Po (Cycling) were presented to share and chit-chat with winners on stage. There were three winners plus 10 merit awards in each category and all of them were invited to attend the Ceremony to receive the prizes. Winners were awarded with trophies, certificates, cash prizes, Ocean Park Daytime Admission Tickets, OAKLEY sunglasses, etc. The biggest award is the Champion of the Open Group who received a HK\$20,000 Free Credit Card Spending Limit

sponsored by Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Asia) Limited ("ICBC (Asia)").

After the ceremony, to recognize the winners and to support the Hong Kong, China Team to the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, the SF&OC also organizes the “**Outstanding Artworks Exhibition cum Olympic Games Exhibition**” throughout the period of Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games (23 July to 13 August 2021). The winning artworks will be displayed together with other Olympic Games related souvenirs at the STNTP and East Point City at Tseung Kwan O. 13 different Olympics Mascot (Miraitowa) will be displayed at the two exhibition venues to signify the 13 sports qualified by Hong Kong, China Team. Members of the public can also take part in the Facebook campaign “Catch the Miraitowa If You Can” in order to win one-night free hotel accommodation valued HK\$5,000. Limited souvenirs of the Olympic Day (first-come-first-served while stock lasts) will also be given out at the two venues during the weekends of the exhibition period. 「2021 奧運日-填色及繪畫比賽」頒獎典禮 優秀作品展暨奧運主題展覽 全城投入撐東奧

由中國香港體育協會暨奧林匹克委員會（港協暨奧委會）舉辦的「2021 奧運日-填色及繪畫比賽」（比賽）已在 6 月 23 日圓滿結束，並在 7 月 24 日於沙田新城市廣場順利舉行頒獎典禮，得獎名單可在詳閱附件。

為紀念國際奧委會 1894 年 6 月 23 日在巴黎成立，國際奧委會將每年的 6 月 23 日定為國際奧運日。過去數年，港協暨奧委會舉辦了各式各樣的活動，例如歡樂跑、BINGO 大挑戰等去慶祝這件盛事。今年，有見新冠肺炎疫情在全球蔓延，港協暨奧委會決定透過不同的平台去推廣奧運精神。

今次比賽分為四個組別，港協暨奧委會合共收到接近 14,000 多份參賽作品，參與熱烈程度令人喜出望外，證明不論男女老幼，都對奧運日充滿熱情和支持。

出席頒獎典禮的主禮嘉賓包括港協暨奧委會奧運日籌備委員會主席湯律掄先生 BBS, JP、民政事務局副局长陳積志先生 JP、以及日本駐香港總領事館大使暨總領事和田充廣先生等。湯主席恭賀各得獎者，他說：「今次比賽的反應非常熱烈，所有畫作水準之高，令評審團費煞思量，幸得秘書處同事協助評審團篩選，再加上評審團連日工作，最終在經過公正嚴格的專業評審後在各個組別選出了優勝作品。各得獎者在如此高水平的比賽中脫穎而出，確是實至名歸。另外，根據比賽章程所列明，奧運日的紀念 T-恤是以先到先得的方式送贈給合作品規格或參賽資格的參加者，但由於參加者非常踴躍，以及活動經費所限，大會未能加印紀念 T-恤，希望參賽者諒解。」

在典禮中，六名現役 / 退役運動員包括崔浩然（劍擊）、伍劭斌（游泳）、李繼賢（游泳）、葉嫻延（羽毛球）、姚潔貞（田徑）及黃金寶（單車）亦有出席並與各得獎者交流心得。比賽各組別均設冠、亞、季軍各一名，及優異獎十名。勝出者將可獲得獎座、證書、現金獎、海洋公園門票、OAKLEY 太陽眼鏡等，而公開組的冠軍得獎者更獨得由中國工商銀行（亞

洲) 有限公司 (「工銀亞洲」) 送出港幣 20,000 元的信用卡免找數簽賬額。

頒獎典禮過後，場地搖身一變，成為以奧運為主題的展覽場地，並聯同今次比賽的優秀作品，在東京奧運會舉行期間(7月23日至8月13日)展出，東奧吉祥物 Miraitowa 亦會以 13 個香港運動員有份出戰項目的形象示人，而將軍澳東港城亦有相關展覽。為加強全城支持香港運動員和增加東奧的氣氛，兩個場地展覽期間將推出【東奧吉祥物 Miraitowa 逐隻捉】有獎遊戲，市民只要即場與東奧吉祥物 Miraitowa 拍照並上載，即有機會獲得兩日一夜的酒店住宿 (連兩份早餐)，價值港幣 5,000 元。而港協暨奧委會亦會在指定時段派發限量奧運日紀念品 (數量有限，送完即止)，有關有獎遊戲詳情及奧運日紀念品派發時間，請密切留意港協暨奧委會 Facebook 專頁 <https://www.facebook.com/sfocHK>。
