



Under the auspices of the SPORTS FEDERATION & OLYMPIC COMMITTEE OF HONG KONG, CHINA, the Hong Kong Athlete Career & Education Programme (HKACEP) provides various supports to the athletes on career and education development. We are now looking for the right candidate to fill up of the **Deputy Manager [Ref. DM(HKACEP)]** post on contract basis, which is renewable subject to the prevailing conditions.

Duties

The DM(HKACEP) will mainly be responsible to

- (a) assist the Office Head for implementation, execution and management of the Programme;
- (b) arrange meetings for the HKACEP Committee and provide clerical supports to the meeting;
- (c) organize official meetings with various stakeholders;
- (d) be responsible for the overall administration; including the implementation of the Retired Athletes Transformation Programme (RATP);
- (e) assist the Office Head to prepare budgets and reports to the government and various stakeholders involved;
- (f) be responsible for handling HKACEP applications;
- (g) keep track of transformation status of individual retired athletes on education, career and life skills support.
- (h) supervise the performance of all subordinates of the HKACEP & RATP Team.

Requirements

Applicants should

- (a) have a recognized university degree and post-secondary qualification in Sports or Recreation Management preferred;
- (b) have at least five years' work experience, with three years solid experience in relevant fields related to the Committee work;
- (c) have experience in coaching management, sport-related committee meetings and school education preferable;
- (d) have excellent command of written and spoken Chinese and English;
- (e) be able to work under pressure and to meet deadlines;
- (f) be devoted to serve athletes and willing to work in irregular hours; and
- (g) have very good analytical, communication and supervisory skills.

All short-listed applicants will be invited to attend a written test. Successful candidate will be offered the post at a salary subject to his background and work experience.

Remuneration

Successful candidate will be appointed on contract basis with monthly basic salary plus gratuity equals to 5% of the total basic salary drawn during the period of contract upon satisfactory completion of the contract. Fringe benefits include MPF, medical, paid leave and employee's insurance.
