東京 2020 奧運會得獎運動員紀念牌匾揭幕

為紀念中國香港代表團在東京 2020 奧運會（東奧）中，歷史性取得一金兩銀三銅的驕人成績，中國香港體育協會暨奧林匹克委員會（港協暨奧委會）在奧運大樓增添了六塊東奧得獎運動員的紀念牌匾，並在今日（11 月 21 日）舉行揭幕儀式。

中國香港代表團在東奧中，由張家朗、何詩蓓、杜凱傑、蘇慧音、李皓晴、劉慕裳及李慧詩，在劍擊、游泳、乒乓球、空手道及場地單車等項目中共取得一金、兩銀、三銅六面獎牌，是香港自 1952 年參加奧運會以來最佳成績，充分證明了香港運動員的非凡實力。

為紀念和表揚得獎運動員的努力和貢獻，港協暨奧委會在奧運大樓二樓的奧運獎牌榜上增添了他們的紀念牌匾。原有的三塊牌匾，包括亞特蘭大 1996 奧運會滑浪風帆金牌得主李麗珊、雅典 2004 奧運會乒乓球男子雙人銀牌得主李靜和高禮澤、以及倫敦 2012 奧運會女子凱琳賽銅牌得主李慧詩的牌匾，亦會以新面貌示人。

港協暨奧委會會長霍震霆先生、東奧場地單車女子爭先賽銅牌得主李慧詩及團長貝鈞奇先生主持揭幕儀式。霍會長指各得獎運動員在比賽中追求卓越、永不放棄的體育精神，值得社會引以為傲。同時他又感激各運動員及體育工作者為推動香港體育發展付出的努力。他期望香港運動員在三年後的巴黎 2024 奧運會中能再創佳績，令紀念牌匾的數量繼續增加。

Unveiling of Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games medalists' commemorative plaques

The Hong Kong, China Delegation to Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games has historic attained 1 Gold, 2 Silver and 3 Bronze, the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (SF&OC) installed 6 pieces of commemorative plaques of the medalists and staged its unveiling ceremony today (21 November 2021) at 2/F of Olympic House.

The Hong Kong, China Delegation attained 6 medals, including 1 Gold, 2 Silver and 3 Bronze in the five sports events, i.e., fencing, swimming, table tennis, karate and cycling by Mr. CHEUNG Ka Long, Ms. Siobhan Bernadette HAUGHEY, Ms. DOO Hoi Kem, Ms. SOO Wai Yam, Ms. LEE Ho Ching, Ms. LAU Mo Sheung and Ms. LEE Wai Sze, carving a milestone in the history of Hong Kong sport. The result is a testimony to the capability of Hong Kong athletes.

In appreciation of the effort and out-standing performance of the Hong Kong medalists, 6 new pieces of commemorative plaques were installed at 2/F of Olympic House. The 3 original plaques in commemoration of Ms. LEE Lai Shan's historic windsurfing gold medal at the Atlanta 1996 Olympic Games, the silver medal by Mr. LI Ching and Mr. KO Lai Chak in the men's doubles in table tennis at the Athens 2004 Olympic Games, and the bronze medal by Ms. LEE Wai Sze in the Women's Keirin race at the London 2012 Olympic Games, were also face-lifted with a fresh new look.

Mr. Timothy FOK, President of the SF&OC, Ms. LEE Wai Sze, the bronze medalist of Women's Sprint event and Mr. PUI Kwan Kay, Chef de Mission of the Hong Kong, China Delegation, jointly unveiled the plaques at the ceremony. Mr. FOK said the medalists had excelled themselves and fully demonstrated the unswerving spirit of sportsmanship, Hong Kong people are proud of their achievement, he also expressed his gratitude and appreciation to all athletes and sports members who work hard to nurture Hong Kong sport. The 2024 Olympic Games will be held in Paris, France, he hopes the Delegation will keep the momentum going and attain a new record by winning more medals, so that the numbers of commemorative plaques will increase correspondingly.
