#### 滑雪運動員金和曉被確診 2019 冠狀病毒病

中國香港體育協會暨奧林匹克委員會（港協暨奧委會）公布，滑雪運動員金和曉被確診 2019 冠狀病毒病，她將安排到隔離酒店進行檢疫，現時情況穩定。

金和曉從波斯尼亞按既定檢疫程序出發到北京，在 1 月 30 日晚上抵達北京機場進行核酸檢測後，被要求再次檢測，並在今早（1 月 31 日）進行的第二次檢測結果中仍呈陽性結果，她現正等候安排到隔離酒店檢疫，現時情況穩定。按組委會《防疫手冊》中的指引，她需要直至核酸檢測結果連續 2 日為陰性，才能離開隔離酒店，再跟據密切接觸者的定義監察 7 日。

至於同行的教練及另一位滑雪運動員翁厚全，他們在機場的檢測結果均為陰性，被界定為密切接觸者，他們會按指引隔離居住，每 12 小時進行一次核酸檢測，若連續 7 日的檢測結果都呈陰性，檢測頻率就可以下調為每日一次，在滿足防疫要求下，他們可以在有條件的情況比賽或工作。

跟據指引，翁厚全仍可以在社交距離下訓練備戰，惟不可以進入公共區域如裝備室等，大會會為他安排獨立的更衣室及洗手間，並會定時清潔消毒。

金和曉原定在 2 月 9 日出戰高山滑雪女子迴轉賽，待她恢復之後將視乎情況參加比賽；而翁厚全的比賽日期為 2 月 13 日，他將出戰高山滑雪男子大迴轉項目，他會在比賽開始前 6 小時再進行一次核酸檢測，如結果呈陰性，就可以參加比賽。

港協暨奧委會將繼續密切留意他們的情況，並提供一切所需協助，會以運動員的健康為最大前題。

#### **Ms. KING Audrey Alice has tested positive for COVID-19**

The Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (SF&OC) announced today Ms. KING Audrey Alice has been tested positive for coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). She has been arranged to isolation hotel, she is now in stable condition.

Ms. KING Audrey Alice departed from Bosnia after completing the necessary requirements and she arrived Beijing on 30 January. She received COVID-19 (PCR) test at the Beijing Airport and was required to conduct a confirmatory COVID-19 (PCR) test. She was tested positive this morning. The Beijing 2022 Organizing Committee (OC) has taken her to the isolation hotel and provided medical treatment. According to the Playbook issued by OC, she is required to have two consecutive negative COVID-19 (PCR) test results with a sample interval of at least 24 hours to be discharged from isolation. Additional countermeasures that apply to close contacts will be adopted for 7 consecutive days.

Mr. RUDIC Marko, Ms. KING Audrey Alice's coach and Mr. YUNG Hau Tsuen Adrian have been tested negative at Beijing Airport, they are classified as close contacts. They will be quarantined and have to follow all the additional countermeasures and testing requirements. They will have to conduct COVID-19 (PCR) tests every 12 hours for 7 consecutive days. If their test results are negative for seven days, the testing frequency will be reverted to normal. They are allowed to work or train under certain regulations.

According to the playbook, Mr. YUNG Hau Tsuen Adrian will be able to train with social distancing, but he cannot get access to confined spaces such as equipment rooms, etc. Individual toilet facility and changing room will be provided for him which will be cleaned on an hourly basis.

Ms. KING Audrey Alice has scheduled to participate in the Alpine Skiing - Salom event on 9 February. Depending on her situation, she may return to the Games after recovery. Mr. YUNG Hau Tsuen Adrian has scheduled to participate his events on 13 February. He will take an extra COVID-19 (PCR) test 6 hours before competition. If the result is negative, he will be allowed to participate.
