6th Asian Indoor and Martial Arts Games Bangkok – Chonburi, Thailand, 21 – 30 November 2024 <u>Athletes Selection Criteria</u> (Tier Two Selection)

As at 17/05/2024

Basic Requirements

Athletes should fulfill the following conditions in order to compete in the 6th Asian Indoor Martial Arts Games (AIMAG): -

- 1) Athletes should pass the required medical check up to demonstrate his/her fitness for competition; and
- Athletes should comply with the requirements (including eligibility code, e.g. HKSAR Passport holder) and guidelines set by 6th AIMAG Organizing Committee, Olympic Council of Asia and SF&OC.

Athletes Selection Criteria can be divided into <u>objective</u> criteria (same for each multi-sports Games) and <u>subjective</u> criteria (to be decided by the Selection Committee for 6th AIMAG). <u>No weighting</u> will be set for these criterions considering that athletes shall be selected once they can fulfill any one of the criterions listed.

A) Objective Criteria

Athletes nominated by NSAs who possess the following outstanding results in previous international competitions shall <u>automatically</u> be selected to participate in the respective Games: -

- * Ranked 1st 8th in recent World Championships (from 2017-2024) sanctioned by the respective IF in the same or higher level of the Games concerned (senior);
- * Ranked 1st 8th in recent Asian Championships (from 2017-2024) sanctioned by the respective IF in the same or higher level of the Games concerned (senior);
- * Ranked 1st 8th in recent multi-sports Games owned by OCA (from 2017-2024) in the same or higher level of the Games concerned (senior) including 5th AIMAG, 18th Asian Games, 19th Asian Games;
- * Ranked 1st 8th in recent National Games organized by General Administration of Sport of China (from 2017-2024) in the same or higher level of the Games concerned (senior) including 2017 13th National Games, 2021 14th National Games;
- 5) * Ranked 1st 8th in recent World Games / Universiade (from 2017-2024) in the same or higher level of the Games concerned (senior) including 2017 10th World Games, 2017 29th Universiade Games, 2019 30th Universiade Games, 2023 31st Universiade;

6) Participated in recent Olympic Games or multi-sports Games owned by ANOC (from 2017-2024) in the same or higher level of the Games concerned (senior) including 2019 1st ANOC World Beach Games, 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, 2024 Paris Olympic Games.

* On condition that there is a minimum of <u>four</u> participants in the competition(s) AND the athlete(s) ranked in the <u>top one-third</u> among the total number of participants.

For **team event**, only if <u>all</u> of the athletes nominated among the team fulfilled the above shall <u>automatically</u> be selected. While for **team only sports**, only if the NSA's previous team fulfilled the above shall <u>automatically</u> be selected.

B) Subjective Criteria

Athletes nominated by NSAs who met the following subjective criteria shall <u>automatically</u> be selected to participate in the 6th AIMAG: -

1) For **team event**, at least <u>25%</u> of the athletes nominated in the team fulfilled the Objective Criteria, or receiving HKSI Elite Training Grant with Elite C or above;

2) For **team only sports**, the team nominated is receiving the support from the Government under the <u>Team Support Grant</u>; or the team nominated meet <u>at least top two-third</u> results in the competitions listed in the Objective Criteria;

3) Athletes receiving HKSI Elite Training Grant with Elite C or above;

4) New sports / events in the 6th AIMAG;

5) Junior athletes who ranked 1st - 8th in World / Asian Junior/Youth Championships (from 2017-2024) with a minimum of <u>four</u> participants in the competition(s) AND the athlete(s) ranked in the <u>top one-third</u> among the total number of participants.
